## "Persecution: Old and new stories on violence and tolerance"

## 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> September 2016

The General State Archives of Greece, in cooperation with the *Digital Museum of Nea Smyrni* participate in the 2016 European Heritage Days organized by the Ministry of Culture.

This year's general theme is: **Persecution: Old and new stories on violence and tolerance**. The related events, organized by the G.S.A., will take place in the premises of the Central Service (G.S.A.), during the weekend of September 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> 2016.

The documents chosen from the sizeable archival collection of the General State Archives (Central & Regional Services) are displayed in the Lecture Hall of the Central Service. This archival material along with the projection of the film *Refugees from Smyrna* are intended to give prominence to tolerance being a merit of a democratic society; only to reduce acts of violence opposing it to the other extreme. The film is a production of the *Digital Museum of Nea Smyrni* based on relevant archival material.

At a time when migration has grown out of proportion both nationally and internationally, awareness on matters of the Contemporary Greek History is of the essence; whether it be viewed as a fundamental humanitarian or political requirement.
